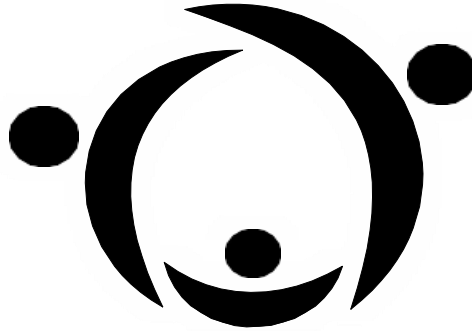

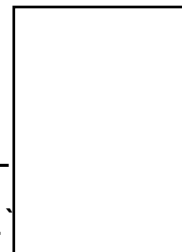

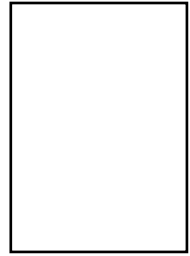

Clause 1 : General Bylaws

- 1.1 All the pupils should turnout in the prescribed uniform every day during the school hours and to all the school functions.
- 1.2 Pupils are advised not to wear costly jewelry or ornaments and to refrain from bringing digital or blue tooth - enabled devices to school. The school shall not be responsible for any loss or damage of such items
- 1.3 During school hours parents/guardians are not allowed to see their wards or their teachers in the classroom without the permission of the Head of the School.
- 1.4 Any communication, request or complaint made by the parents/guardians should be addressed only to the Head of the school and not to the class teacher.

- 1.5 Any willful damage caused by the pupil to the building, furniture, apparatus or any other school property is liable to be made good by the parent/ guardian.
- 1.6 Students who are ill for a long period must produce a Medical Certificate.
- 1.7 Homework assigned to the pupil by the teachers should be done regularly and parents / guardians are requested to co-operate with the school authorities by checking the homework of their wards.
- 1.8 Students should be punctual to school and bring the prescribed books as per timetable.
- 1.9 Students are eligible to write the Examination only if they have 80% of class attendance.

Clause 2 : SPECIAL FEATURES OF NAAHAR PUBLIC (CBSE) SR. SEC.SCHOOL

- 2.1 We are following the curriculum pattern of CBSE / NCERT for classes KG to XII
- 2.2 English as medium of instruction for all the classes.
- 2.3 The campus includes a calm and serene environment with spacious classrooms.
- 2.4 We have sufficient infrastructure facilities for both curricular and co-curricular activities.
- 2.5 School Provides school bus facility for students from KG to XII (40 km radius)
- 2.6 Transcendental Meditation (T.M.) based on the Unified Field of Technology of his Holiness Maharishi Mahesh Yogi with Yogasanas and Pranayama and Science of Creative Intelligence are an important and regular part of the daily programme. This has been incorporated to improve the learning ability and explore pupil's full mental potential. Experiments have proved beyond doubt that regular practice of Transcendental Meditation does improve learning ability, memory power, receptivity power of expression, creativity and improves physical and mental health and social behavior.
- 2.7 Lives of great men are studied as a source of inspiration for students.
- 2.8 Development of the total and multi-sided personality of the students is the major objective of the school.
- 2.9 Guru Pooja and Group Bhajans are conducted every Thursday morning at Cogitation Centre
- 2.10 Basic Knowledge of Electronics and Computer is also being imparted.
- 2.11 Junior Lab for classes V, VI, VII & VIII are available.
- 2.12 School Counselors have been appointed. These counselors serve as School - Home Liaison officers too. Counseling for developing skills in adolescents

is also provided by trained teachers. As per CBSE rules embracing the idea of diversity is the reality and therefore, each child is a unique learner.

- 2.13 The board sensitized and brought out a document related to poor Performance of schools focusing on the major issues of children with Special needs (CWSN) and other co-morbid disabilities. At NAAHAR PUBLIC SCHOOL, we practice inclusivity of education and take conscious effort to ensure all learners including CWSN access along with other children and receive customized support and instruction. Teachers are duly trained by CBSE and the parents of CWSN are given needed orientation from time to time. Highly interactive and play way methods are used with technology to sustain the learning interest of the Children.
- 2.14 Learning by doing, teaching by storytelling experiencing through activities (Experiential learning), Art Integrated curriculum is practiced at Kindergarten and Primary classes. Science-Technology-Engineering- Mathematics (STEM) & digital technology supported learning in all the branches of knowledge through multimedia. **We are associated with Aakash for NEET / JEE Coaching for Grade - XI & XII & APEX Foundation course for Grade - VI to X.**
- 2.15 Learning and reinforcement of Mathematical concepts through practical demonstrations and introduction of non-routine topics are practiced at various level.
- 2.16 The National flag is hoisted during the assembly session on every Monday.
- 2.17 Leisure time of children is ideally utilized by making them view subject related videos to enhance their knowledge.
- 2.18 An Information Technology Centre is operational for conducting IT Courses.
- 2.19 Worksheets are introduced in all primary classes for increasing the creativity and comprehension level of the pupils.
- 2.20 To help the students who are low in their academic performance, our devoted teachers spend an extra hour in the evenings (after school hours for remedial needs). Parents are requested to co-operate in picking up their wards from such coaching classes.
- 2.21 Well accorded digital education content is being used in smart classes for all students. The school also operates a school app with e-contents (available on Play store / App store), which is duly created and maintained by respective classes / subject teachers as an extended support.

2.22 As per the letter from Directorate of School Education, Chennai - 600006, received in the month of October - 2014, it is ordered that Tamil shall be taught as a subject from classes I to X in all schools.

CLAUSE 3: ADMISSIONS AND WITHDRAWALS

3.1 Admissions:

- 3.1.1 While seeking fresh Admission to classes other than LKG, parents should produce Transfer Certificate from the school where the child last studied, duly signed by the competent authority. Application for admission into any class should be accompanied by Original Birth Certificate, Aadhaar card and a Medical Certificate, certified by a Registered Medical Practitioner, (if applicable), Attendance Certificate and Old Progress Card
- 3.1.2 A child seeking admission to Class-1 should have completed 5 years and 6 months of age as on 31st March. The age for admission to other classes shall be reckoned accordingly. Relaxation in age is not permitted. The pupil should have learnt Tamil as one of the two languages in the previous class of study for admission to classes VI to IX. However, it is desirable to have studied Hindi as one of the 3 languages for one academic year at least, while seeking admission for classes VII to IX.
- 3.1.3 This school will admit students for classes up to IX and XI, by producing T.C. issued by any State / Central government recognized schools, duly certified by competent authority of the Education Department. However direct admission for classes X and XII will be strictly as per CBSE guidelines and subject to Board's approval.
- 3.1.4 Candidates seeking admission to class XI should have any of the following Criteria: (a) Obtained a pass certificate in the All India Secondary School Examination(AISSE) conducted by CBSE, or (b) Passed an equivalent examination conducted by any other recognized Board of Secondary Education in India or overseas Board recognized by CBSE as equivalent to its Secondary School Examination.

3.2Withdrawals:

- 3.2.1 Application for Transfer Certificate (T.C.) should be submitted in writing to the Head of the School by the parent /legal guardian of the pupil. A minimum of two weeks (or as and when the EMIS portal gets updated) is required for the issue of the T.C.
- 3.2.2 Students who intend to leave the school should clear the entire outstanding fee before taking the T.C.

3.2.3 A student once removed from the roll will be re-admitted only after the payment of re-admission fee of 3000/- (Rupees three thousand only).

CLAUSE 4: PERFORMANCE REPORT

4.1 The academic performance reports shall be distributed periodically to the students after **Midterm, Quarterly, Half-yearly & Annual exams in the CBSE - prescribed format.**

CLAUSE 5: RULES FOR PROMOTION

- 5.1 A student is eligible for promotion in classes I to IX & XI only if he or she has 80% of the attendance from the total number of working days for which the school has worked from April to March of the academic year. The same is also applicable to classes X & XII for appearing in board exams.
- 5.2 For III Language, there will be an internal examination at the end of class VIII. Students should complete the internal examination positively.
- 5.3 Non-payment of school fees in stipulated time **debars a student from appearing** for annual examination and the report book shall be withheld.

CLAUSE 6: CURRICULUM

The syllabus and curriculum followed are the same as those of Central Board. We have well qualified and competent team of teachers devoted to their work.

CLAUSE 7: LANGUAGE PATTERN

Class I to XII	: I Language (English Compulsory)
Class I to X	: II Language (Tamil / Hindi / Sanskrit)
Class I to VIII	: III Language (Hindi / Tamil/ Sanskrit)

From class I to VIII study of III languages are mandated as per curriculum.

Learning Tamil as a language is compulsory from the academic year 2015 - 2016. (Refer to page no. 15 / point no. 22). From the academic year 2026-27 all students who write board exams in Tamil Nadu, will have to write Tamil exam along with other subjects for their class X board exam.

CLAUSE 9: SCHOOL FEES

9.1 School fees (Tuition/term) can be remitted annually or in four quarterly installments, to the school account. The fees may be paid through online portal/by cheque /in cash/ credit/ debit card to the school office.

9.2 Parents are encouraged to pay the entire fee for the whole year. However, the school operates in four terms.

TERM 1 - 1st APRIL to 30th JUNE

TERM 2 - 1st JULY to 30th SEP

TERM 3 - 1st OCT to 31st DEC

TERM 4 - 1st JAN to 31st MARCH

CLAUSE 10: CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Dear Student,

You are a unique person filled with latent potential. We would like to help you explore the richness of your character. To achieve this, we need your co-operation and collaboration. Self-imposed discipline will help you to acquire ideals, interest, right attitudes, good habits, etc.

The following would be highly helpful to you as guidelines:

- 10.1 Perform Yogasanas regularly and Transcendental Meditation twice a day. Be loyal to your school, teachers and companions.
- 10.2 Complete your home assignments regularly. Successes depend on your hard work and do your best in your studies and complete all the assignments given to you by the school.

- 10.3 Be cheerful and optimistic, radiating joy in your surroundings. Be co-operative and be ready to help others in times of need or when occasion arises.
- 10.4 Be honest and sincere in all your dealings.
- 10.5 Cleanliness is next to Godliness. Be clean in your personal hygiene, i.e. body, heart and mind, as well as maintain cleanliness of your environment.

CLAUSE 11: GENERAL RULES

- 11.1 The school authorities will not be responsible for the loss, damage or theft of pupils' belongings. It is not advisable for the pupils to bring money or valuable articles to school.
- 11.2 Although the school is not responsible for the behavior of its students outside its premises, due notice will be taken to reports on misbehavior and motor vehicle rules violation. Upon enquiry through proper channel if the report is substantiated then disciplinary action will be taken against the concerned students.
- 11.3 Any damage done in the class or in the school premises has to be made good. Pupils must take care of the equipment that has been lent for their use.
- 11.4 Speaking in English is enforced in the school and within the school premises.
- 11.5 The students must note down the work assigned for the next day in their Hand book. As a backup the same will also be available on their school app.
- 11.6 Students are expected to be punctual. Late comers are liable to be sent home at the parents' own risk. Absence on the-opening day will be viewed strictly. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence for more than a week, habitual idleness, disobedience or objectionable moral influence would justify dismissal.
- 11.7 Finger-nails and Hair for boys must be cut short and kept clean. Hair colouring is not permitted
- 11.8 When the students go to playground or move along the corridors while Changing classes, they must walk in silence and in a single line. They Should always keep to the left
- 11.9 Students are expected to come to school with all that is necessary for the day's work. Borrowing or lending pencils, erasers, rulers, sharpeners, instrument box etc., is discouraged.

- 11.10 Personal cleanliness and hygiene are greatly recommended to all. Students should be particularly careful not to litter anything in the school premises. They should use the baskets and bins specially provided for this purpose.
- 11.11 Absence without proper information or prior permission will be considered as a gross breach of discipline.
- 11.12 The name of students who are absent for a month without informing the school authority will be struck off from the register.
- 11.13 The school takes adequate care about the safety of the students. However, the school will not be held responsible for any injury or accident met by the pupils.
- 11.14 During unavoidable and abnormal circumstances, we may declare as a holiday (Online classes will be scheduled). On such days the school buses will not ply to pick up the children to school. In case the holiday announcement came late, (i.e.,) after the arrival of children to school, they will be retained in the school till noon. However, parents who wish to take them back home earlier than noon time must come in person to collect their wards.
- 11.15 Students may be involved in various school activities throughout the year. While parents will be notified of major events in advance, for smaller activities, students may be engaged without prior notice. We will always prioritize student safety and ensure, activities are age-appropriate and supervised by qualified staff.
- 11.16 Students' photos may be shared on the school's social media platforms for promotional purposes. These photos may include individual and group shots taken during school activities, field trips, and events.

Parents: If you do not wish for your child's photo to be shared, please contact the school office. We respect your privacy and will ensure your child's image is not used.

CLAUSE 12: CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

In order to provide holistic educational experiences and good citizenship training to children, the school organizes different co-curricular activities through various Houses, Clubs, Educational Tours, Resource Specialist Programmes, Social Service Projects, Audio-Visual Education, Fine Arts, Scouts & Guides, Cubs & Bulbuls, Bunny Activity, JRC, Music classes, Science of Creative Intelligence, Yogasanas and Pranayamas. Programmes to motivate lateral thinking in students are devised and incorporated along with school curriculum.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The school fosters a high degree of competency in several co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and the children are encouraged to participate in any one of the activities at a time. Activities include formal training in Bharathanatyam, Carnatic Music, Metal Band, Drums, Key board, Tabla, Guitar, Fine arts, Gymnastics, Karate, Skating, Silambam, Track & Field (athletic) events, Futsal and other Games like Badminton, Cricket, Handball, Football, Volleyball, Hockey and Tennis.

CLAUSE 15: SCHOOL BUS SERVICE

RULES & REGULATIONS:

1.
 - a) Admission does not ensure school bus service.
 - b) Availability of school bus facility entirely depends upon the scheduled timings and location.
 - c) The bus runs for the convenience of the students without any liability whatsoever on the part of the authorities of the school.
 - d) Any change of residence, does not guarantee continuity of the Service and parents must make their own arrangements.
 - e) Any of the pupil is found indiscipline while travelling in the school bus, he / she will be removed from the school bus facility.
 - f) The bus facility is available from KG classes to XII.
 - g) The bus facility will be extended if there is a minimum of 30 students availing the bus for both ways.
 - h) Drop facility only to town campus would be provided for students participating in remedial classes, only if they are bus users. Parents shall pick them up on their own, if otherwise.

The school transport fee is much lower when compared to the auto and public transport rates. Our school transport is fitted with CCTV, speed governor and GPRS in compliance with govt. safety norms. Hence you are encouraged to avail our school transport facility. The Students travelling by school bus will be picked up & dropped, at scheduled spots as planned and finalized by the school and not as per Parent's customized wishes.

Note:

- A. If the residence of the child is located in a narrow or blind end street, it would only be possible to pick up the child at a pre-determined place on the main road.
- B. As it is not possible to provide door to door service for everyone, the stages fixed by the management shall be final.
- C. No adult is permitted to accompany the child in the School Bus.
- D. On no accord should any transaction, of whatever description be, with any of the staff accompanying the student in the bus. Any such transaction will only be at the parent's student and will not bind the school authorities in any way. The Management does not hold itself liable for any damage or loss of belongings incurred by the student during the transit in the school bus.

CLAUSE 16: TRAFFIC RULES

Rules to be followed:

When Walking

- ❖ Walk only on the pavement or foot path.
- ❖ If there is no pavement, walk on the right-hand side of the road so that you can see the oncoming traffic towards you.
- ❖ Always walk one behind the other when there is a heavy traffic. Do not rush.
- ❖ Do not behave in the street as you do in the playground.

When Crossing

- ❖ Cross the road at a zebra crossing or traffic light crossings or where there is a police officer or a traffic warden.
- ❖ Look for traffic in all directions and listen carefully.
- ❖ Cross when there is a safe gap and make sure there is enough time.

While Cycling

- ❖ Look behind before starting off, turning right or left, overtaking, or stopping and make sure it is safe.
- ❖ Give a clear arm signal to show what you intend to do.
- ❖ Always keep both hands on the handlebars unless you are giving a signal or Changing gears.
- ❖ Do not wear earphones / headphones or use a mobile phone whilst cycling. These devices affect your concentration.

CLAUSE 17: PARENTAL UPDATE

- 17.1 This Hand Book is the most effective medium of Parent - Teacher Communication. Parents are requested to check the Hand Book daily, look in for homework endorsement made by the teacher and to communicate their queries through the Hand Book.
- 17.2 Parents who seek information or wish to make suggestion should do so to the Head of the School. The Head of the School can only be met on all working days during the Visitor's timings. Parents can meet teachers regarding the child's progress after getting permission from the Principal and may do so only during the break times.
- 17.3 Parents and guardians are requested not to meet their children or interview the teacher during class hours without prior permission from the Head of the School.
- 17.4 Parents are expected to co-operate in the work of the school by enforcing regularity, punctuality and discipline, by taking interest daily in their children's progress. They should check diary daily, note the home work and see that the home work is done.
- 17.5 Medical inspection is held once a year. Parents are requested to follow the suggestions given by the Medical Officer.
- 17.6 The School will strictly adhere to the schedule of working days and holidays as mentioned in the Hand Book. Only in extraordinary circumstances, if there is a Government announcement of a holiday for educational institutions, then the school will not function.
- 17.7 Cycle-parking: Though school safeguards the cycles parked by the students in the school premises during the school hours, the school will not be held responsible for the loss of any cycle. It is the sole responsibility of the pupils to lock the cycles carefully and not allow them to be misused by his/her friends.
- 17.8 Parents are requested to ensure that their wards practice Yogasanas and Transcendental Meditation daily which are taught in the school.
- 17.9 Ensure that your wards study and then sign in their Hand book everyday mentioning their study hours.
- 17.10 Observation class: Parents may have the privilege of observing the child's class-room activities during the school working days with prior permission of the Head of the School.
- 17.11 Pupils should bring only vegetarian food to the school.

- 17.12 Field Trip Consent: Parents are requested to give their consent if the school arranges a field trip to support the smooth functioning of the programme.
- 17.13 For any school-related queries or concerns, parents are requested to meet and discuss the same only with the Head of the School in the school office.
